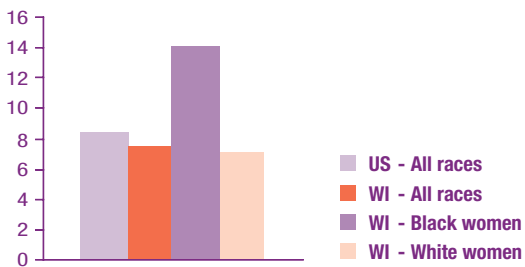

## Incidence and Mortality

- The incidence rate was 7.5/100,000 for a score of 2.
- This is lower than the national average of 8.4/100,000.
- *The incidence rate in last year's report was 10.5/100,000 for a score of 1.*
- The mortality rate was 1.7/100,000 for a score of 2.
- This is lower than the national average of 2.5/100,000.
- *The mortality rate in last year's report was 1.8/100,000 for a score of 2.*
- Incidence rates were higher among black women than white women; mortality rates were not available by race.

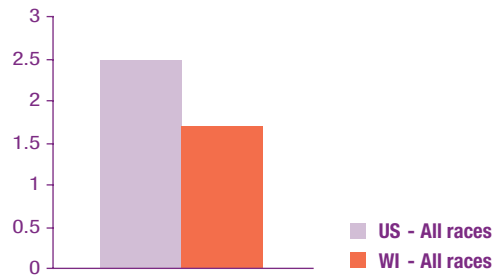
### Cervical Cancer Incidence

US and WI (# of deaths per 100,000 women)

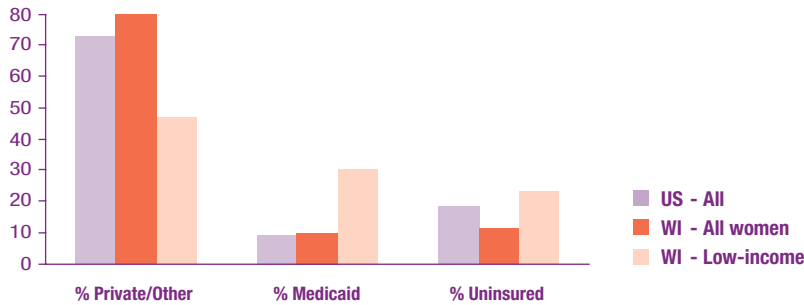


## Healthcare Access and Utilization

- The cervical cancer screening rate was 85.7% for a score of 1.
- This is lower than the national average of 85.9%.
- *The screening rate in last year's report was 84.9% for a score of 1.*
- In this state, Medicaid offers unrestricted coverage of HPV testing, for a score of 2.
- In this state, 11% of women are uninsured for a score of 1.
- This is lower than the national average of 18%.
- *The rate of uninsured in last year's report was 9% for a score of 2.*
